Woodvale is proud to announce a new elite program in the Northern corridor - The Woodvale Athletics Academy.

This program is for students who wish to extend their knowledge and skills in the disciplines of track and field. The College will provide elite level teaching and learning that will enable each student to improve in a range of track and field disciplines.

Not only will Academy students engage in bi-weekly training, they will be offered opportunities to be assisted by expert coaches, to develop their strength and conditioning, be involved in officiating programs and be guided by presentations from current successful athletes.

The Course

The aim of the program is to:

- Develop individual skills
- Develop skills in coaching and statistical analysis
- Conduct athletic related fitness testing and develop programs to improve individual fitness levels
- Provide coaching courses
- Analyse individual skill performance
- Understand the physiological and skill requirement for athletics at an elite level
- Undertake Sports Medicine Australia training programs including first aid and injury prevention and management
- Provide information relating to diet and nutrition

Note: Students enrolled in this program substitute Athletics for general Physical Education classes in Years 7 and 8. They will be enrolled in general Physical Education classes in Years 9 and 10.

APPLICANTS SHOULD BE AWARE THAT THE FOCUS OF THE COURSE IS ON DEVELOPING AND IMPROVING INDIVIDUAL SKILLS AND FUNDAMENTALS

Selection in this program may lead to timetable conflicts with other courses. The College will make every effort to accommodate all course selections; however, scheduling conflicts may arise from year to year, and students, along with their parents, may need to prioritise certain courses over others.

Selection

Students are ranked initially based on the following criteria:

- Reference Forms provided
- Academic reports
- Social and behavioural progress, as indicated in the Attitude/Behaviour/Effort domains and report comments

1. Selected students are invited to trial.
2. Offers are made after the trial.
3. To retain their place in this program, students must maintain high standards in all aspects of College life.

Expectations

Students may only enrol in one of the Athletics Academy, Specialist Basketball **OR** Music Program.

Students in the program may also enrol in the Academic Extension and Enrichment Program. Those who accept a place in the program are expected to continue with the program through to the end of Year 9 at a minimum.

Failure to honour the conditions of the agreement, may result in the student being removed from the program.
